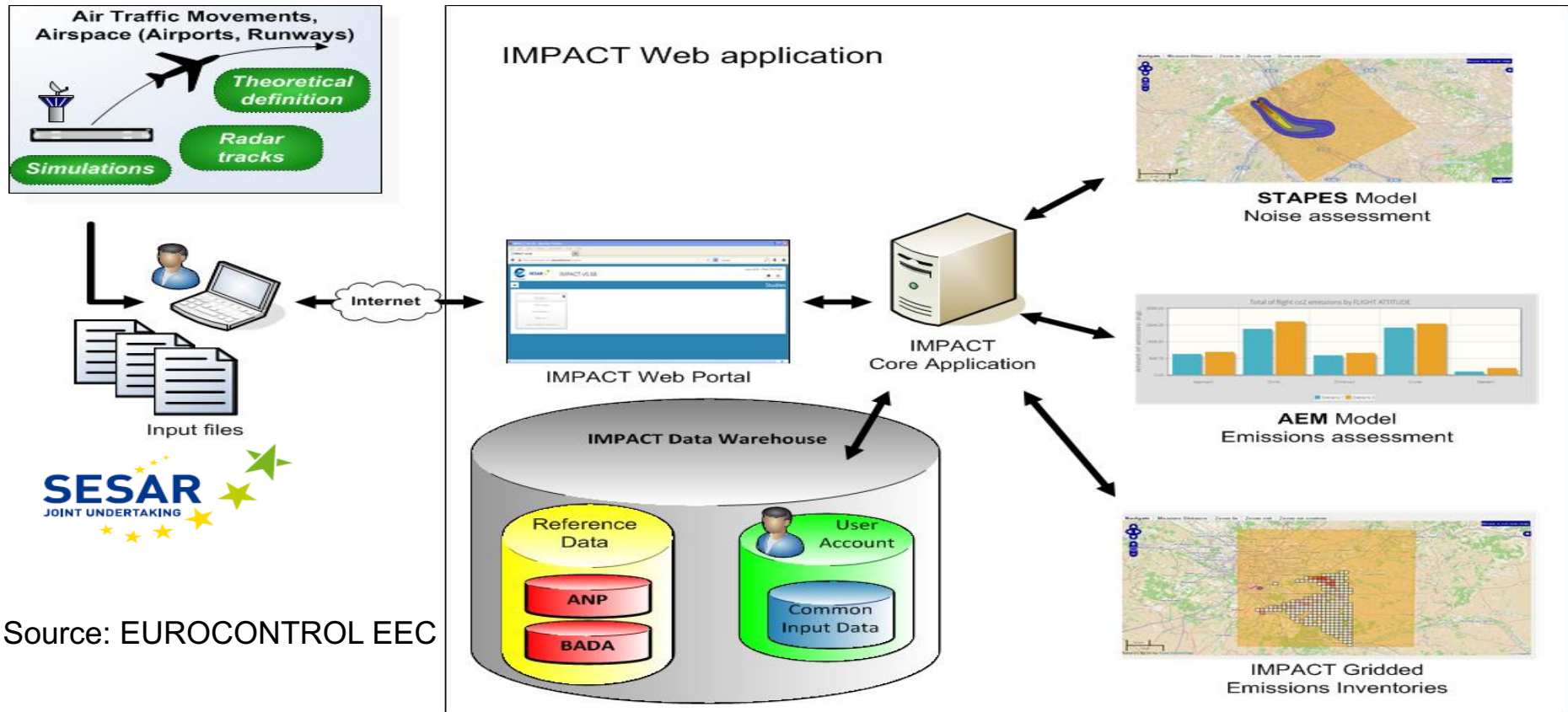

- Free for assessments made for SESAR

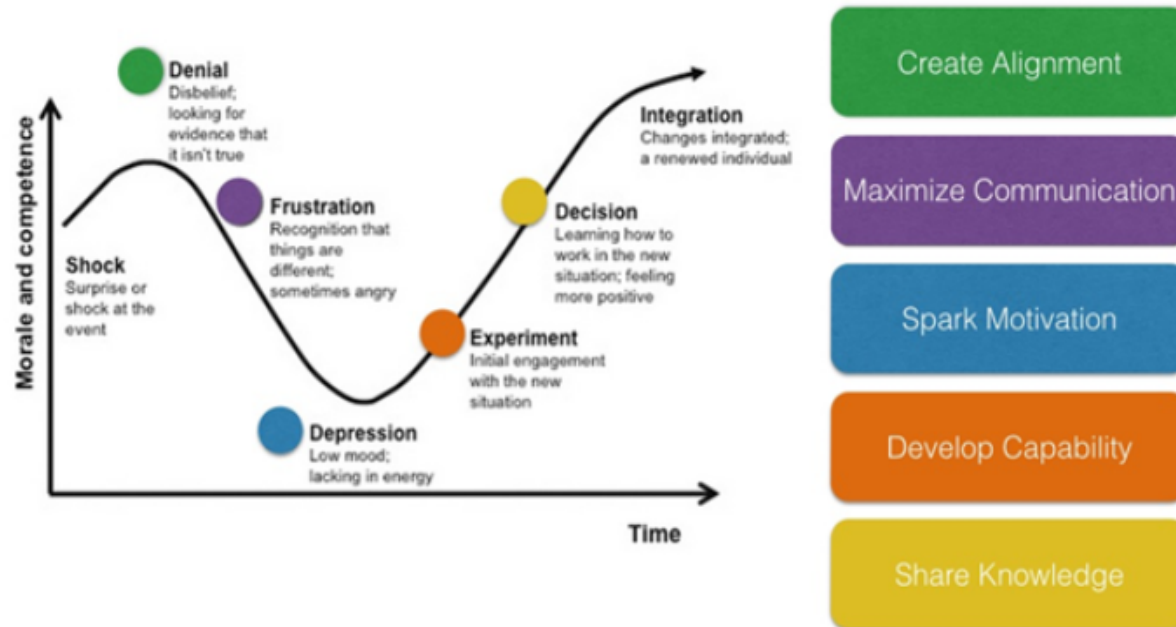
