Aeronautical information publication

- the AIP Slovenia is published by Slovenia Control Slovenian Air Navigation Services, Limited on behalf of the Ministry of Infrastructure for the LJUBLJANA FIR
- part 3 Aerodromes
- aerodrome geographical and administrative data and operational hours





Departure

- 06:00 till 23:00 FF-cat 6 or higher on req.

- 23:00 till 06:00 FF-cat 3 or higher on req.

- FF cat up to 9





Approach

- 06:00 till 23:00 FF-cat 6 or higher on req.

- 23:00 till 06:00 FF-cat 3 or higher on req.

- FF cat up to 9





Exemptions

Urgent flights

- -Slovenian police and military for the ACFT that are in compliance with *ICAO Annex 14*, fire fighting category 3 (H3)
- -search and rescue flights
- -flights for providing medical assistance and emergencies in disasters
- -medical flights







Number of operations

2018 – 35.000 - 31.000 (without training flights)

2019 – 32.000 - 28.000 (without training flights)

2020 – 28.000 - 24.000 (without training flights)





Night flying restrictions — AIP (on the request of Civil Initiative Šenčur)

Between 22:00-06:00 LT flight operations are subject to the following restrictions for noise abatement reasons:

- between 22:00-00:00 LT RWY 30 will not normally be used for departures; pilots shall expect departures on RWY 12 (departures mainly in the direction of Vodice)
- between 00:00-06:00 LT departures on RWY 30 are not permitted

(departures only in the direction of Vodice)

These restrictions do not apply to departures for safety, meteorological, technical and SAR reasons.
