

## ICCAN's first two years

- Established in January 2019
- Since met with hundreds of stakeholders
- Published our Future of Aviation Noise Management report in March 2021
- Completed first 2-year work programme in April 2021
- Set out a new Corporate Strategy with four key ambitions




#### Impact of Covid-19 pandemic

- Covid-19 has transformed the aviation landscape
- We reviewed and adjusted our work programme to reflect circumstances:
  - ➤ Adopted remote working staff welfare & programme of digital engagement
  - ➤ Delayed publication of two pieces of work from April a review of noise metrics & consultation toolkit
- Delivered on original work programme despite the pandemic
- Took opportunity to survey people while skies were quieter
- Chance to rebuild aviation in more sustainable way



## Summer survey 2020



- A snapshot of people's experiences of aviation noise in summer 2020
- Undertaken with 2000 people living close to five UK airports
- Wanted to see how attitudes might change as the aviation industry seeks to recover
- Key findings were, during lockdown:

reported hearing less aviation noise




had not noticed any changes to flight paths

were bothered during the night (between 11pm and 7am)



#### Engagement best practice

- Conscious of impact of Covid-19 on airport engagement
- Looked at existing practices and international case studies
- Captured views from local communities about what works well, and where improvements could be made
- Set out recommendations on Noise Forums and how best to set one up
- Also continuous engagement, why it's important and how it helps to build social capital



# Airspace modernisation and change



Practical help and support, drawing on current best practice




### New projects
